General Info

Animal Care internships are available on a part-time (2 full days/week minimum) or full-time (40 hours/week) basis. Full-time interns must be able to commit to at least 6 weeks and part-time interns for a minimum of 10 weeks. If you are interested in interning with our outreach or education departments, please call first for available opportunities.

Housing

Housing is available to full-time interns and includes shared bedroom, bathroom and kitchen facilities. Interns are required to share in household chores and keep their living space clean. A \$250 housing deposit is required upon acceptance of your internship and will be refunded at the end of your stay, as long as the accommodations are left in the same condition as you found them. Interns have access to a full kitchen, but must provide their own food. Regretfully, we cannot accommodate companion animals in our intern housing.

Vegan Living
